Guidelines for Authors of Educatum

Educatum (ISSN 0975-2641) is a peer reviewed journal published annually in July month since 2004 containing articles in various aspects of Education and behavioral science. Original research findings, critical review articles and research notes on any areas of education with emphasis on teacher education are considered for publication. Submission of manuscript for publication implies that it is not being considered for publication elsewhere. Authors should make sure that they are not infringing on any copy right. Permission must be obtained by the authors from the copy right holder for reproducing the material and the source is acknowledged. The editorial board assume no responsibility for statements and views expressed by contributors. If author's piece of work infringes any existing copyright, publisher will have to be indemnified for any such breach by author. The word limit is 2000 words for original research papers and review articles and 1000 words for research notes. Manuscripts must be submitted online in MS words and one hard copy by post to the Chief Editor, Educatum, G.C.M. College of Education, New Barrackpore, Kolkata-700131. Only selected articles will be published after peer review of manuscripts in the Journal. Manuscripts not considered for publication will not be returned. So the authors should keep the copy with them. It is under correspondence for inclusion of Educatum in UGC recommended Journals.

Peer Review and Publication Policy

All received manuscripts are initially scrutinized for suitability within the journal. If found suitable, article is further sent to a reviewer for review process. Identity of author/s is not disclosed to the reviewer and vice-versa. On receipt of feedback from reviewer, editorial board analyze the feedback and further decides to accept, reject or revise the paper. If paper is accepted, it will be considered for publication. The Journal reserves the right to make necessary editorial amendments in the final manuscript to suit journal's format. Single complimentary copy will be provided to first author only by post in India free of cost. Papers are accepted purely on the basis of merit by recommendation of learned referees.

Guidelines for Authors

1. All submitted manuscripts must be original work and it is not submitted elsewhere for publication. Authors should acknowledge all sort of assistance for completing the work.
2. After submitting the manuscript, until the editorial decision is communicated or if the manuscript is accepted for publication, without prior approval from the editor, authors cannot publish the manuscript in other publication.
3. Manuscripts are to be submitted online at educatum.gcmcollege@gmail.com Maximum length of the manuscript should be 2000 words.
4. Main attachment should contain full text content including title of the manuscript (limited to 6 words) at the top, an abstract of 200 words and up to 5 Key Words.
5. Author's names should not appear on anywhere on the body of the manuscript to facilitate the referred and review process.
6. The text should be double spaced and should be typed in Times New Roman style with a font size of 12 pts and 1 inch margin all around. Use standard indentation for paragraphs.
7. Footnotes should appear at the bottom of the page on which they are cited/ referenced.
8. Tables and Figures should be numbered in Roman Numerals and can appear either in the body of the manuscript or at the end of the manuscript. Sources of data used in both tables and figures should be duly acknowledged as a footnote to the same. In case some abbreviations and acronyms are used in the tables and figures, these should be duly described in the main body text of the manuscript where they have been cited/ referenced/interpreted and well as in the footnotes of the table/ figure.
9. Tables and figures appearing at the end of the manuscript should be duly referenced in the main body text where these have been interpreted. Plates/photographic images must be avoided.
